### *Valencia, Spain*

Renowned as the birthplace of paella, Valencia is also famed for its unique mix of Baroque cathedrals, futuristic architecture, lively plazas, lush parks, and sprawling beaches.

### *Ibiza, Spain*

A playground for European bohemians in the 1960s, today Ibiza—nicknamed the “White Island”—is a holiday hotspot with whitewashed houses, a beach-blessed coastline, bars, restaurants, and chic shops.

### *Alicante, Spain*
